Aligned to the 2022-2025 Contribution Plan outlining the P&C financial commitments to resources and upgrades; fundraising, grants and sponsorship planning makes it achievable.

Enrichment Tree in Term 1 - coming up for its third year is very successful at funding classroom resources early in the year so the students have full benefit. This has replaced traditional P&C Levies.

Major Fundraiser in Term 2 - Pre-covid we were known for our annual Mother's Day Fete - a fun community event which was only possible with a huge commitment from the parent/carers community.

Sponsorship - is a key element to our fundraising that involves community businesses partnering with the school in the form of donations either as Gold \$10,000, Silver \$5000 or Bronze \$2000.

Grants - are available for most of the key outdoor projects - often up to 50% of the project funded.
