Photo Competition Guidelines for P&C Associations



Eligibility

- The photo competition is open to Parent and Citizen Associations (P&C Associations) affiliated with a public school in NSW.
- Only current members of the P&C Federation are eligible to participate.
- Each P&C Association may submit a maximum of three photos.
- Entries must be original photographs taken in the past 12 months.

Theme

- The photos should capture the spirit and activities of your P&C Association.
- Photos can showcase events, fundraisers, volunteering activities, parent-teacher interactions, school initiatives, or any other relevant aspect of your association's work.

Technical Requirements

- Photos must be in digital format and submitted in JPEG or PNG file format.
- The minimum resolution for the photos should be 3000 pixels on the longest side.
- File size should not exceed 10MB per photo.

Submission Process

- All photo submissions must be made using the provided submission form.
- Each photo file should be named with the P&C Association name, followed by a sequential number (e.g., ABCSchoolP&C_01.jpg).
- Along with each photo submission, provide a brief description (maximum 100 words) explaining the significance of the photo and how it represents the P&C Association.

Originality and Ownership

- Participants must ensure that they are the original creators of the submitted photos.
- Photos must not infringe upon any third-party rights, including copyright or intellectual property.
- By submitting photos, participants declare that they hold all necessary rights and permissions to use and distribute the photos.
- Participants are responsible for retaining permissions for use of the photographic likeness of any
 minor under the age of 18 years old where the minor can be identified. Permission must be
 obtained in writing from an adult with authority to grant photo permission.

Photo Editing

- Basic photo editing, such as adjustments to brightness, contrast, and cropping, is allowed.
- Photos with excessive digital manipulation or composite images will be disqualified.
